

Aleksandar Risteski received his B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees in telecommunications at the University Ss. Cyril and Methodius, Skopje, Macedonia in 1996, 2000 and 2004, respectively. He is currently a professor at the same university, Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Information Technologies. From 2008 to 2016 he was a vice-dean for research and international cooperation at the Faculty. In 2001, 2003 and 2004, he had several internships at IBM T. J. Watson Research Center, Yorktown Heights, NY, USA, where he worked towards his PhD degree. His research interests are in the field of cybersecurity, blockchain technologies, optical communications, ICT for energy efficiency, and coding theory. He is an author/coauthor of more than 100 journal and conference papers, several book chapters and two books. He has mentored 7 Ph.D. and more than 50 M.Sc. candidates. He was a project leader of one bilateral and two national research projects and also a participant in several national and international projects sponsored by European Commission and IBM. He has also led or participated in more than 50 industry-related R&D or consultancy projects, with rich experience in preparation of studies, basic designs, detailed designs, technical specifications, tender dossiers, reviews, evaluations, supervisions, expert opinions, etc. in the areas of electrical engineering and information-communication technologies. Prof. Risteski is member of IEEE since 1997, member of the Society for Electronics, Telecommunications, Automatics and Informatics (ETAI) since 1996, member of Chamber of licensed architects and licensed engineers since 2013, and member of Chamber of court experts since 2013.

Prof. Risteski was president of the Information Theory Chapter within Macedonian Section of IEEE (2020-2023), member of the Board of Accreditation and Evaluation of Higher Education of Macedonia (2011-2015), President of Society for Electronics, Telecommunications, Automation and Informatics (ETAI) of Macedonia (2009-2014), independent member of the Board of Directors of Makedonski Telekom (2005-2007). Currently, he is Deputy President of the Engineering Institution of Macedonia (since 2025), Board member and General Assembly member of Chamber of court experts (since 2024), and member of University Senate, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje (since 2023).
